I own property around the Little Manistee River and have gathered information regarding the initiative of the LMWCC as I will be impacted by the proposed changes.

LMWCC has not identified any specific activities that precipitate the need for such drastic action and therefore, is an overreach into the rights or property owners. Conversely, it is the property owners who have to deal with litter, noise, trespassers, privacy issues, disrespect toward property owners along the Little Manistee and watershed areas, and in some cases destruction of property, as it relates to those using the waterways of and on the Little Manistee.

Our township already has zoning in place to protect our natural resources that includes setbacks from shorelines so the actions of the LMWC are redundant and adversely affects landowners along the Little Manistee and its watershed area and threatens private property ownership rights in general.
