Peacock Township Planning Commission's Resolution recommending zoning district amendment

On the March 2, 2023, the Peacock Township Planning Commission after publicized notice conducted a public hearing at the request of Mr. John Kerssan, to expand the C/LI zoning district to construct a commercial storage building. The planning commission having conducted the public hearing and receiving comments from citizens in attendance and finding that the rezoning request by 3–2 vote is consistent with the township's master plan.

Now, therefore, be resolved that the Peacock Township Planning Commission recommends an amendment to rezone the following:

from an existing "R-1" District zoning classification to "C/LI" District zoning Classification. Parcels 43-06-035-010-00 and 43-06-035-011-00. "Part NE1/4 of NW1/4 beginning at NW corner, thence East 150 ft, thence South 350 ft, thence West 150 ft, thence North 350 ft to POB Section Thirty-Five (35), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) West.

With the provision that if the subject parcels are not used for a commercial storage building then the zoning classification shall revert back to R-1.
